

2015/16 PE & SPORT GRANT ALLOCATION

The government is providing additional funding for the academic years 2013-2014, 2014-2015 and 2015-2016 to improve provision of physical education (PE) and sport in primary schools. This funding - provided jointly by the Departments for Education, Health and Culture, Media and Sport - will be allocated to Primary School Headteachers

The allocations are calculated using the criteria below : -

17 or more pupils aged 5-11 years (January 2015 census) receive £8,000 plus £5 per eligible pupil;

16 or fewer pupils aged 5-11 years (January 2015 Census) receive £500 per eligible pupil.

Details of Expenditure Sept 15 – July 16

Greasbrough Primary School has spent the grant to continue to provide all teachers with CPD opportunities in PE with specialist staff from Live and Learn. The coaches are in school all day Monday providing high quality PE lessons alongside CPD for teachers on a rolling programme. This ensures every pupil receives 2hrs of PE each week. They also provide sport at Monday's Breakfast Club. We have a Sports Co-ordinator is also employed as a sports coach across the collaboration which a partner school. They lead on PE lessons all day Tuesday including a morning session for our Breakfast Club.

Live and Learn provide an after school club for 25 children which alternates each term – Football, Indoor Athletics, Gymnastics, Tag Rugby, Tri Golf & Cricket. The Sports Co-ordinator provides a sports club on a Tuesday which also alternates each half term to - Multisports, Orienteering, Basketball and Athletics. There is another external provider on a Friday for Musical Theatre. School contributes funding for some places for pupils through Pupil Premium Grant and contribute the short fall. Rotherham United Community Sports Trust provide sporting activities for the children every lunchtime

Pupils in Y2 and Y6 spend a day at the English Institute of Sport at an annual event which involves pupils competing with other schools. We work within our community cluster to provide a variety of sporting events with other school on a regular basis.

There are regular sporting tournaments that children attend during the school day and after school. The transport for such events is paid for through the grant.

Year 4 children have Swimming lessons for a term. The grant pays for the sessions and transport to the swimming baths.
